Forms of Payment

Cash, and Credit Cards are accepted for ticket purchases and merchandise sales. Concession stand accepts Cash only.

Ticket Pricing

Individual tickets \$7 general admission – Group rate of \$5 per ticket for group of 25 or more (groups must purchase in advance or contact General Manager to schedule group night).

Ballpark Ticketing

Individuals viewing game from areas surrounding the ballpark, including; 3rd base parking area, along the outfield fences are required to purchase a ticket.

Children Tickets

Children 6 years of age and older require a ticket to enter Fort Marcy Ballpark. Children under the age of 6 are not required to have a ticket.

There are NO refunds or exchanges for individual game tickets.
All sales are final.

Pass the Hat

Bring your Dollar bills!!! Pass the hat is an old time baseball tradition offering player incentive when hometeam players preform outstanding plays by collecting cash from fans. Santa Fe Fuego staff will pass the hat for every home team homerun, hometeam pitcher that strikes out the side, hometeam pitcher who pitches a full game and other outstanding plays made by hometeam players.

Fans Code of Conduct

The Santa Fe Fuego are committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for our guests at Fort Marcy Ballpark.

Our staff will proactively intervene to support an environment there guests can enjoy experience free of unacceptable behavior, including the following:

- *Foul/abusive language or obscene gestures.
- *Intoxication or other signs of impairment related to alcohol consumption.
- *Displays of affection not appropriate in a public, family setting.
- *Obscene or indecent clothing.
- *Any disruption of the game or event, including throwing of objects or trespassing on the playing field or in restricted areas.
- *Fighting, taunting or making threatening remarks or gestures.

Any guest not adhering to the above code or behaving in an unruly manner will be removed from the ballpark. The Santa Fe Fuego management reserve the right to determine what unruly or unacceptable behavior is.

If anyone is interfering with your enjoyment of The Santa Fe Fuego game, please contact the nearest Fuego event staff for assistance.

Backpacks and Other Bags

All bags are subject to search upon entry. Prohibited items will not be allowed inside the ballpark (see “prohibited items” for more information).

Beverages, Food & Containers

No bottles, cans, beverages or containers may be brought into Fort Marcy Ballpark, with the exception of sealed bottled water. Santa Fe Fuego will make every effort to accommodate fans with dietary restrictions.

Alcohol Management

Alcohol will be sold each night of the 2019 season Thursday through Sunday. No alcoholic beverages may be brought into or removed from Fort Marcy Ballpark. New Mexico State Law prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of 21.

Please note the following policies:

- Patrons will be required to show proper proof of age when purchasing alcoholic beverages at Fort Marcy Ballpark Park.
- New Mexico Law prohibits patrons from purchasing and/or possessing more than two alcoholic beverages at a time.
- Alcohol will not be served after the bottom of the 6th inning or 9pm, whichever comes first.
- The Santa Fe Fuego and Kellys liquor reserve the right to deny the sale of alcoholic beverages to any guests.
- Do not allow anyone to attempt to drive if intoxicated. Assist guests to the Main Ticket Booth to arrange a ride.

Prohibited Items

No bottles, cans, beverages, containers or coolers may be brought into Fort March Ballpark, with the exception of sealed bottled water. For everyone's safety, fireworks, weapons, nets or any other item that may be considered dangerous or may interfere with another fan's enjoyment of the game. Please be aware this is a partial list of prohibited items and any questions should be directed to the General Manager at 505-204-2093

Autograph Requests

Guests may make autograph requests from the Fuego players/coaches and visiting teams up to 15 minutes prior to game time and immediately following end of game.

Field Trespassing

Any guest attempting to enter the field of play before, during or after an event without authorization will be removed from the stadium and subject to criminal prosecution and/or fines.

Kids Run

Kids from 0 – 100 have the opportunity to run the bases in the middle of the 4th inning (subject to change or cancellation). Kids enter the field on the 1st base side, lining up at the fence near the home team dugout at the beginning of the inning.

National Anthem Performance

Those wishing to perform the National Anthem at a Santa Fe Fuego game may submit a request to the General Manager.

Pets & Service Animals

Pets, and service animals, must be accompanied by the handler and leashed at all times, handler is responsible for cleaning up after pets.

Unruly or aggressive animals may be required to leave at the discretion of the Fuego management.
